2019 FLIGHT SCHEDULE

NOTE: We ONLY use Bass Cat clear plastic official weigh in bags - only 25 in circulation

ALL FISH MUST BE PRESENTED FOR WEIGH-IN WITHIN 30 MINUTES of last angler weighed.

Be prepared to depart: Line up flights 7 to 10 minutes prior to YOUR take off time.

Take-off Pontoon located in the arm of creek will be calling take-off boat numbers.

Allow 30 minutes time for Live well Check, Check In area located **AT CHECK OUT BRIDGE** on boat dock. Look for the Blue Flashing light

ONLY USCG approved – ONLY OEM Running Lights are allowed and REQUIRED!

No Rub Rail or Power Pole running light without OEM Style

We do not pinch the tail on measurement

TURN IN THE PAINT PADDLE WITH YOUR TEAM NUMBER

BLACK ON FRIDAY AND RED ON SATURDAY AS YOU COME IN FOR WEIGH-IN!!!

ALL drawings are done Saturday on Day Two from the RED numbers on Paint Paddles!

The **Draw Boat** and all boat drawings will be presented at the Weigh In Saturday.

Elimination drawing to 3 teams per flight Saturday - Must be present to win.

Three (3) paddles from each flight will be drawn, or one (1) for every 25 boats

Take Off and Weigh In will be held at Prairie Creek area

USE THE RIGHT SIDE of Cove TO ENTER AND THE OPPOSITE SIDE TO EXIT!!!

Please Idle until number is verified and you're released!

Stage for take-off either left or right of pontoon towards your destination.

Incoming traffic will be crossing lake from Highway 12, White River and Rocky Branch

Largest Striper (20") OR Hybrid - 20" Minimum

Largest Walleye - 18" Minimum Length

*Largest Ozark Bass (Rock Bass or Goggle Eye) - No Minimum length
